Each year, Libra season begins with a perfect poise: the autumn equinox. For one brief moment, day and night stand equal, neither outweighing the other. At 2:19 pm on September 22nd, you might even try the old tradition: see if you can stand an egg upright on its end. Balance becomes literal.

Libra, sign of beauty, relatedness, and otherness, enters with colors advancing toward us, with leaves turning sunset-gold and flame-red, making the whole landscape feel like it is leaning closer. A single leaf can be enough: nature's ordinary object becomes a work of art. Philosopher George Santayana once wrote that beauty is "objectified pleasure." We project our inner delight outward until it seems to dwell within the world itself. That flaming maple leaf, that golden orchard hillside; suddenly it isn't just us who are pleased, but the leaf itself seems radiant with delight. He said, "beauty, as we feel it, is something indescribable," a reminder of how easily we mistrust our own subjectivity. Nothing real could come from inside us, could it?

And yet, this year's skies swell with water planets: Jupiter in Cancer, Saturn in Pisces, Mars rushing freshly into Scorpio on equinox day itself, with Neptune soon to follow. They irrigate our senses, soaking perception with feeling, as if to counter the dryness of this year's shortened apple harvest and muted leaves. What is parched in the fields can still be replenished in the psyche.

Libra's gift is objectivity, and science itself is a Libra art. But even science arises from the subjective witness; the flexing galaxies hidden in someone's eyes.

Quantum physics shows us what Libra has long known: the observer changes the observed. Nature is robustly creative, deeply relational, and always mysterious. As Rachel Carson once wrote: "The more clearly we can focus our attention on the wonders and realities of the universe about us, the less taste we shall have for destruction." Wonder itself becomes a path to peace.

Libra invites us to relate to true otherness. Not to flatten others into symbols or positions, allies or enemies, but to see them as whole beings, so that we may relate wholeheartedly and become more whole ourselves. The seasonal ruler this year is Venus in Virgo, reminding us to linger longer on the details. Virgo is the contemplator, the craftswoman. She steadies relation by giving it texture, a cadence, a frequency. Through her, we entrain ourselves more deeply to the nourishing nuances of nature and of each other.

On October 13th, Venus enters her native Libra, becoming the artist of the season, meeting the world with balance and grace.

And she doesn't act alone: the outer planets are in rare harmony with Libra this year. Uranus in Gemini and Pluto in Aquarius form an airy triangle of fresh thought, while Neptune in Aries sparks new life, reminding us that beauty and wonder can move ideas forward. On this same day, Pluto turns direct in Aquarius, the sign of the individual, urging us to keep close Libra's lessons of beauty and real relatedness, so individuality strengthens rather than divides

## The Lunar Notes

- Full Moon in Aries – October 6th

## Libra Crystals

- Lapis Lazuli – heightens fairness, truth, and clarity.
- Rose Quartz – heart-centered compassion and gentle relation.
- Emerald – harmony in partnerships and creativity.
- Opal (traditional Libra stone) – amplifies beauty, creativity, and relational sparkle.

Crystals hold distinct frequencies, and each zodiac sign has its own archetypal rhythm. Because we ourselves are oscillatory beings—breathing, pulsing, living by circadian tides—these stones can resonate with us.
